Sponsor Attendee Tickets

Sponsors of all levels receive free tickets to the event.

Table Space

Sponsors that have a dedicated table included will receive a 6' rectangular table at the Computer History Museum venue. You may display products and materials or swag giveaways.

This is a great area to connect with the audience and passers by. Please note the 6 foot width limitation avoid large displays or things that will overlap adjoining space.

Silver sponsors have use of half of a 6' rectangular table.

Other important booth considerations are:

- Power
 - Limited to 1 standard electric outlets
- Internet
 - Will be provided as WiFi.
- Banner/Signage
 - Should go ON or BEHIND your table. Please do NOT put anything in front of your table
- Booth/Assignments
 - Each sponsor will receive a booth number assignment from the organizing team prior to the event. First come, first served with regards to booth assignments and pitches.

2-minute Pitch to Entire Audience

Companies have a deadline of **May 14** to provide accompanying powerpoint slides for their 2 minute pitch. After review by the devopsdays SV organizers these slides will be provided to the A/V team. After May 14, there is no possibility of accompanying slides.

Shared Giveaway Table

• Sponsors are free to put their materials on this table for passers by to review and pickup. Keeping the giveaway table supplied is the responsibility of the sponsor.

FAQ

- **1.** How many scanners do we get? None. devopsdays Silicon Valley is not that kind of conference. You are responsible for collecting information directly from attendees.
- 2. Do we get any sponsored talks? No. There are no sponsored talks. We do not give precedence to companies who sponsor for the longer 20, 30 minute talks.
