# **General Sponsor Activities**

### Sponsor On-Stage "Shoutout" / Pitch

A benefit of sponsoring is to have the opportunity to have someone from your team come on stage in front of the unified audience and take 10 minutes if you're a Platinum sponsor or 2 minutes if you're a Gold sponsor to talk about whatever you want to talk about related to your company. That can be a pitch, a call out for something cool about your company, a reason to come by your table, etc.

## **Specific Sponsorship Info by Level**

#### **Platinum Sponsors**

Each Platinum sponsor has the ability to have a staffed display table during the full duration of both Days of the event.

- The table is a (2) 6' x 30" rectangle and will have 4 chairs provided.
- Table setup is at 8:00am on Day 1, or after 2:00pm the day before.
- Teardown starts at 3:00pm on Day 2.
- There will be power strips provided.
- Recommend using retractable banner type signage rather than a booth 'wall' display. Space is limited
- All tables will have cloth skirts provided by the venue, unless you wish to bring your own.

### **Gold Sponsors**

Each Gold sponsor has the ability to have a staffed display table during the full duration of both Days of the event.

- The table is a 8' x 30" rectangle and will have 2 chairs provided.
- Table setup is at 8:00am on Day 1, or after 2:00pm the day before.
- Teardown starts at 3:00pm on Day 2.
- There will be power strips provided.
- Recommend using retractable banner type signage rather than a booth 'wall' display. Space is limited.
- All tables will have cloth skirts provided by the venue, unless you wish to bring your own.

#### **Silver Sponsors**

Each Silver sponsor has the ability to have a staffed display table during the full duration of both Days of the event.

- The table is a 6' x 30" rectangle and will have 2 chairs provided.
- Table setup is at 8:00am on Day 1, or after 2:00pm the day before.
- Teardown starts at 3:00pm on Day 2.
- There will be power strips provided.
- Recommend using retractable banner type signage rather than a booth 'wall' display. Space is limited.
- All tables will have cloth skirts provided by the venue, unless you wish to bring your own.

#### THERE WILL BE A SIGN ON THE TABLES INDICATING WHICH ONE YOU ARE ASSIGNED

#### Notes/rules for ALL Sponsor Levels:

- Do not bring food/drinks the venue prohibits outside food/drink.
- There cannot be a table in front of the doors you can put signs by the door opening, but nothing that might interfere with the walkways.
- Nothing can be stuck / hung on the walls.
- You cannot interfere with walkways or other sponsor spaces, so please do not bring very large displays, gear, or extra chairs from elsewhere in the venue.
- No external amplifiers or other loud audio.
- Nothing can be stuck/hung on any walls.
- SWAG/giveaway items must adhere to the <u>Code of Conduct</u>.
